Boats registered in the Leigh Dabchick One Design Class shall carry in addition the Class Insignia.

8. **Class Register.** A Register shall be kept by the Secretary of the Committee, of all boats built to the Class, which have been measured and Certified in accordance with Rule 5. Such Register shall contain the name and number of each boat, the name and address of owner, and such other particulars as the Committee shall think fit. The Committee shall have the power to render invalid the Certificate of Measurement of any boat ceasing to comply with any of these Rules. The Secretary of the Committee shall be informed of all changes of ownership, address or name of boat.

9. **Minimum Weight of Hull.** The *Minimum* weight of the hull, unrigged, and without centreplate and rudder, but with buoyancy equipment, shall be 280 pounds. Any boat in default of this shall have attached to the lower side of the centre thwart, lead weights as necessary to bring the weight to the stipulated figure.

10. **Hull and Spars.** The hull and spars shall conform to the Official lines, dimensions and Specification.

11. **Sails, Rigging and Equipment.** The sails, rigging and equipment shall conform to the official dimensions and Specification.

12. **Buoyancy Equipment.** Buoyancy apparatus sufficient to give a positive buoyancy of 100 pounds in sea water shall be securely fixed in all boats.

13. **Crew.** The racing crew shall be two persons, including helmsman, both hands to be amateurs.

14. **Whisker Pole.** A whisker pole will be permitted, providing that it does not exceed six feet in length.

15. **Racing Equipment.** During a race each boat shall carry anchor, anchor cable, rope or chain; one pair of oars; rowlocks, and a bailer.

16. **Trapezes Etc.** Trapezes and similar contrivances will not be permitted.

17. **Modification of Rules Etc.** The foregoing Rules are effective as from January 1st, 1951 and until further notice. Any suggestions for modifications to the Rules, etc., shall be made to the Secretary of the Committee. The Committee shall, on any suggestion being referred to them have absolute discretion to take any action they may think fit. Reference may be made by the Committee to the Owners' Advisory Committee.
