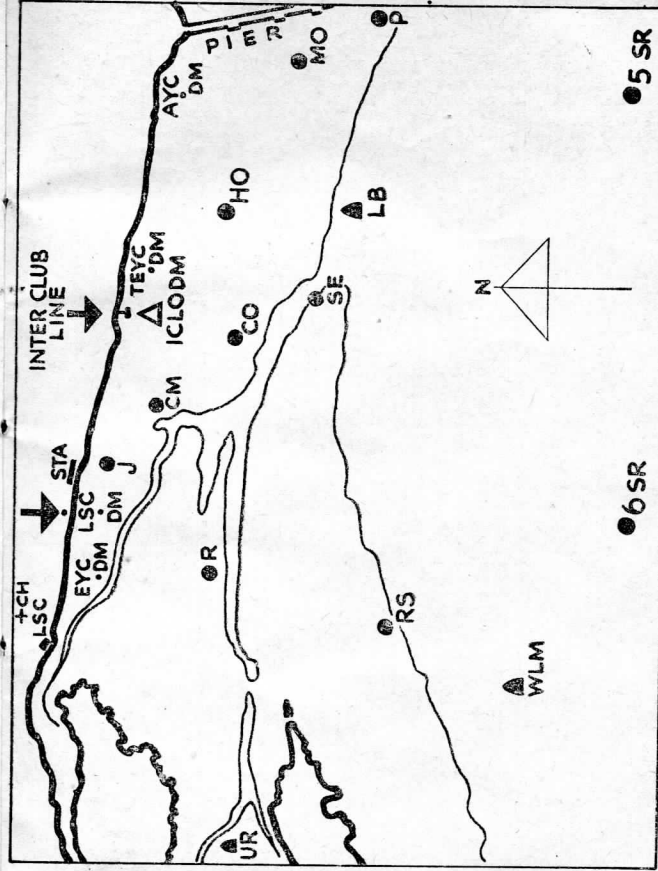

The Times of High Water are Clock Time.  
0 hrs. is Midnight and 12 hrs is Noon.

The Times and Heights of High Water are for Southend Pier. The Height given is the higher of the two daily tides above Chart Datum.

The Times of High Water at Whitstable, Harty Ferry, Queenboro, Cockham Woods, Benfleet, Holehaven and Leigh are approximately the same as at Southend Pier.

The Times of High Water at Burnham, are approximately 20 min. earlier than at Southend Pier.

The Times of High Water at Dover are approximately 1 hour earlier than at Southend Pier.

The Times and Heights of High Water may differ considerably from those predicted, owing to the effects of winds, atmospheric pressure, flood water, etc.
