SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. All races shall be sailed under the rules of the I.Y.R.U. and the R.Y.A.

2. Crews of yachts under 8 tons (T.M.) shall consist wholly of amateurs and the number of persons in yachts of 5 tons (T.M.) and under shall not exceed five.

3. All yachts taking part in any race shall be under the direction of the Race Officer.

4. The Race Officer shall have the power to shorten the course or postpone any race.

5. Prior to a yacht's first race a Form of Entry must be completed, giving particulars of hull, rig, etc., and forwarded to the Sailing Committee.

6. A declaration must be made in accordance with I.Y.R.U. Rules—the time limit being 7 days (except in special circumstances for which the Sailing Committee may extend the period at their discretion). Said declaration should be signed on the special sheet provided on the Sailing Notices Board.

7. Entries and Entrance Fees of all visiting yachts must be in the hands of the Sailing Secretary prior to the race to which they apply. The Entrance Fees of all yachts registered in this Club become due immediately succeeding the last race in the season, and will be assessed from the Result Sheets.

8. Each yacht shall carry a distinguishing flag in accordance with R.Y.A. Rules.

9. Recalls. A Sound Signal will be made if possible. The onus for returning and crossing the line in the proper manner will be with the yacht or yachts concerned.

10. Courses, for all classes, are printed on cards and are available at the Club House.

11. Cancelled races may be resailed at a later date. Dates for such resails will be posted on the Club Sailing Notice Board.

12. The Course number will be exhibited on the board at the Starting Hut.

13. All races are "open" events.

14. All yachts not carrying their Racing Numbers in a prominent position must take the risk of not being recognised by the Race Officer and of not being timed in.

15. All yachts sailing in events sponsored by the Club shall, if requested by the Sailing Committee, provide a certificate of measurement.
