SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- All races shall be sailed under the rules of the I.Y.R.U. and the R.Y.A., excepting as modified herein.
- Crews of yachts under 8 tons T.M. shall consist wholly of amateurs and the number of persons in yachts of 5 tons T.M. and under shall not exceed five.
- All races are open events and a member of any R.Y.A. recognised club may compete.
- All yachts taking part in any race shall be under the direction of the Race Officer.
- The Race Officer shall have the power to shorten the course, abandon or postpone any race.
- Prior to a yacht's first race a Form of Entry must be completed giving particulars of hull, rig, etc., and forwarded to the Sailing Committee.
- Entry Forms and entrance fees of all visiting yachts must be in the hands of the sailing secretary prior to the race to which they apply. The entrance fees of all yachts registered in this club become due immediately succeeding the last race of the season and will be assessed from the results sheets.
- Printed course instructions for all classes are available at the clubhouse.
- The course number will be exhibited on a board at the starting hut at, or prior to, the ten minute gun of the class to which it applies. The course may be changed before the ten minute gun without special signal.
- The Class distinguishing flags shall be as follows:—
 "A" Class—Swift Catamarans International Code A
 "B" Class—Shearwaters International Code B
 "C" Class—G.P. 14s International Code C
 "D" Class—Handicap International Code D
 "F" Class—O.K. Dinghies International Code F
 "Q" Class—Bona-fide Cruisers International Code E
 Combined Classes ("All-in") International Code T
- The L.S.C. starting line is formed by bringing into transit the pole on the starting hut with the pole immediately south of the starting hut and is limited by the distance mark which is not necessarily on the line itself. The distance mark is a pole with an orange basket topmark.
- Recalls.*—A sound signal will be made but recall numbers will not be used. The onus for returning and crossing the line in the proper manner will lie with the yacht or yachts concerned. The class flag will be left at the dip until premature starters have returned.

Clocks will be advanced 1 hour to British Standard Time on Sunday, 18th February, at 2 a.m.

The times of High Water at Whitstable, Hartly Ferry, Queenboro', Cockham Woods, Benfleet, Holehaven and Southend are approximately the same as at Leigh.

The times of High Water at Dover are approximately 1 hour earlier than at Leigh.

The times and heights of High Water may differ considerably from those predicted, owing to the effects of winds, atmospheric pressure, flood water, etc
