1. *Racing Rules.*—All races will be sailed under the rules of the I.Y.R.U., R.Y.A. and Classes Association Rule except when modified as follows.

3. *Entries*
- (a) *Entries* for classes 4, 1, C, R, X & A will normally be accepted on the starting line. However, for open meetings, certain combined races and all races for class '2' completion of an entry form will be required.
  - (b) Prior to a yacht's first race details of the yacht must be forwarded to the Sailing Committee.
  - (c) An entry fee of 50p for senior members or 25p for cadets may be charged for summer racing excluding open meetings).

4. *Starting*—The L. S. C. has two starting areas:

(a) *On-shore Line*

The on-shore line is situated approximately one hundred yards west of Chalkwell Station off the L.S.C.'s East Rack. The starting line is formed by bringing into transit the pole on the Starting Hut with the pole immediately South of the Starting Hut which limits the Northern end, and is limited at its Southern end by a Distance Mark which is not necessarily on the Starting Line itself. The Distance Mark is a pole with an Orange Basket top-mark.

(b) *Off-shore Line for Ray Starts*

The Off-shore Line is formed by bringing into transit two white buoys on the South Bank of the Ray, South of Chalkwell Station and is limited by the Starting Boat, and the Northern of the two white buoys.

All yachts will observe I.Y.R.U. rule 4.4.a(i).
